Dear Whom It May Concern,

For most of my life, conservative values, faith, and love of country have shaped the way I lead, work, and live. While career and family rightfully took precedence over the years, I have never stopped caring deeply about the direction of this country and the future being handed to the next generation. Today, I feel strongly that it is time for me to step back into the arena and put my energy, experience, and voice to work in a more direct way.

That is why I am now seeking to return to politics in a meaningful role where I can contribute my experience, energy, and commitment to the conservative movement. I want to be part of an effort that stands clearly for faith, freedom, responsibility, secure borders, fairness, and the courage to defend truth. Just as importantly, I want to help encourage the next generation to become informed, engaged citizens who are unafraid to stand up for their values and participate in the political process.

My leadership journey began early as Student Body President in high school and as a leader of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes at the Nick Bollettieri Tennis Academy in Florida. My political organizing experience began in Wyoming in the late 1980s, where I helped raise funds and organize grassroots support for the U.S. Senate campaign of Alan Simpson. I also contributed to the campaign of Dan Sullivan for the Wyoming State Senate. In 2004, leaders within the Colorado Republican Party approached me and held multiple meetings regarding a potential run for Colorado State Senate in the 16th District. Although family considerations ultimately led me to decline, I remained engaged in conservative political efforts in the years that followed.

In early 2016, I began organizing grassroots support in Colorado for Donald Trump's presidential campaign. Working independently and at my own expense, I built an early volunteer network across the state, recruited more than 100 volunteers, and traveled throughout Colorado speaking at grassroots meetings and recruiting supporters. On April 15, 2016, I organized a rally on the steps of the Colorado State Capitol that drew thousands of supporters.
